Before we begin the unit on Day 1, I will first introduce the five senses to my sons. We will start by singing Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes. And then we will read Look, Listen, Taste, Touch, and Smell by Pamela Hill Nettleton and also Cold, Crunchy, Colorful by Jane Brocket as an introduction. Day 1: Hearing
