Grades of Paper

GCSE's are now graded 9-1 with 9 effectively being a grade above the old A*, A level 4 is now considered as a low C grade and a 5 a high C grade, or low B grade. Level 6 is a solid B, 7 an A grade and a level 8 an A*. The foundation papers for each subject are graded from 5-1 and the higher papers from 9-3.

PAPER GRADES. Paper may be defined in terms of its use. Each grade serves a purpose, usually suggested by its grade name. Some of the most common classifications of printing papers are bond, coated, text, cover, book, offset, index, label, tag, newsprint, and writing.

Filter Paper Grade 1. Circles: 10 mm to 150 cm (available prepleated) Sheets: 26 x 31 mm to 600 x 600 mm. Particle retention 1: 11µm. Nominal thickness: 180 µm. Nominal basis weight: 87 g/m². Nominal ash content 2: 0.06%. Grade 1 is the most widely used filter paper in routine applications requiring medium retention.

Sandpaper of grade between 24 and 36 is used to deburr concrete, paint and stone. Sandpaper of grade that falls between 24 and 60 is used to trim the surface of old paint and metal. 46-120 grade sandpaper is used to clean the surface of sandstone, brick and solid wood. Sandpaper grade of 60 to 120 is used to remove leftover paint stripper.
